

1. God spoke to Moses from a burning bush at Mt. Horeb (aka Mt. Sinai) (Exo. 3:1-2). Locate Mt. Horeb/Mt. Sinai in your Bibles, or Bible Atlas if you have one. Read Exo.17:1-7 and discuss what God did there and what the Israelites did at Mt. Horeb.
2. By reading Deut.1:6-8, 5:1-2, and I Kgs 8:9 we can see that Mt. Horeb played a very special part in the Israelites history. What are some things you have learned about Mt. Horeb?
3. **In Exo.3:6 it says,** “*And he said, “I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.”*” What is significant about God saying this to Moses? What significance does this have for our faith? After your discussion read Matt. 22:32 and Jesus will answer both questions.
4. Read **Exo.3:7-8** share with your group when the Lord saw a time in your life when you were suffering, and He delivered you.
5. **Exo. 4:10-14** is Moses giving God another excuse as to why he is not the right man for the job. He is begging God to send someone else. What are some of the excuses you have given God for not doing what He wants? Be Honest! Remember I have asked many of you to be a Life Group Hosts and Facilitators and I have heard your excuses. Therefore, God has heard your excuses.
6. Is there a time that comes to your mind when you believe you probably “angered God” like Moses did with his excuses?
7. Read **John 14:12** – It says, “*...greater works than these will he do...*” What are some greater works than these can we do? I don’t mean to make a list of what we can do. I mean what GREATER WORKS can we do. Let’s Getter Done!
8. Butch closed with **Rom. 10:13-15** after reading those verses discuss how Fairway can accomplish this passage. How can Fairway be the greatest “sending church” in the world?
9. What is stopping Fairway from delivering people that are stuck in the bondage of sin? Are we like Moses? What excuses are we giving to God?
10. Well do you want to please God and help build His Kingdom? Or do we want to anger God and give Him some excuses as to why we can’t build His Kingdom right now.
