Elders Meeting Minutes March 18, 2024

The March Elder's meeting was called to order with the following elders present: Harry Harris, Fred Holland, Harv Buckner, Paul Cook and Roger Brown. Presenters attending: the Preaching Minister, Butch Gastfield; Chairman of the Deacons, Michael Bolter; and Church Administrator, Chris Callahan.

Roger presented the opening meditation and prayer.

The February minutes were accepted and approved.

The Deacon's report was presented by Michael. We now have twenty-one active deacons. Michael shared that Gerald Raver is the Team Captain for the Parking Lot for the Fairway Experience ministry. Gerald currently has 16 volunteers and is hoping to recruit a total of 28. Michael shared that the Deacons covered all the events over the past very busy month. He also mentioned that he, and several other Deacons helped with the brunch for the Women's retreat ministry.

The February Administrative report was presented by Chris. The financial report was approved. Chris shared details regarding the congregational meeting, FORWARD UPDATE, scheduled for Sunday, March 17th, at 4pm, & Thursday, March 21st, at 4 pm. The fly-through animation will be shown as part of this presentation as well as the history, current status, financial details and the path forward. This will be placed on the website in late March. Chris shared that the builder, Collage, will begin work the week of April 1st. Chris shared that he has asked Collage for a time and action plan for construction to ensure we have adequate parking for the weekend services. Harv and Chris shared details regarding the groundbreaking ceremony and 25th Church anniversary event scheduled for April 7th at 2pm.

The Preaching Minister's Report was presented by Butch. He highlighted the successful events in the Men's Ministry in March: the BBQ, Golf Outing and Men's Breakfast. He was involved in a number of important coordination meetings with area Christian Church leaders, planning efforts for the church plant, with great news coming soon and a number of internal projects that are ongoing. He addressed the many ongoing Bible study and class opportunities that are currently available and the planning ongoing for the summer months. He outlined the upcoming Easter musical and services to include the Good Friday service at 5:00 PM. He mentioned that the choir is now up to 48 members. The Isaacs concert was a great success. He also reminded that the Vietnam Veterans Celebration, put together as part of the Military Outreach Ministry, is scheduled for March 26 at 2:00 PM.

Under Old Business, several topics addressing ongoing actions to update information on the website were discussed and updates provided.

Under New Business, administrative support for the church plant, women's ministry newsletter articles and ideas for service changes were discussed. Harry provided the closing prayer.

The next monthly Elders meeting is scheduled for April 22nd.

What's Going On In The Parking Lot?

Where do worship services at Fairway begin? They begin in the parking lot! Our parking lot isn't just a space for cars. It's an opportunity for ministry! It's a place for making visitors feel welcome before they even enter the church.

The parking lot is a welcoming place, a place for outreach, to make a great first impression with a warm smile and helpful assistance that sets the tone for a worship service. For first time visitors, it's not just about finding a spot for their car, it's about finding a spot at Fairway.

The Parking Lot Ministry goes beyond hospitality. As our church renovation project begins, we will see construction trailers, equipment and building supplies staged throughout the parking lot, which will make parking cars much more challenging. Parking Lot Greeters will play an essential role ensuring that we each are able to park our cars safely and smoothly.

Greeters will direct traffic flow to parking spaces, assist worshippers with special needs, provide directions to drop-off zones and reserved spaces, prevent accidents, and ensure the safety of everyone.

The only requirements are thirty minutes of your time before worship service and a sense of humor! The Sheriff's Department will provide training, and you'll be outfitted with a reflective vest and radio.

Beginning April 10th *Emotionally Healthy Spirituality*Led by Jim Jacobs, Associate Minister
