

Elders Meeting Minutes April 15, 2024

The April Elder's meeting was called to order with the following elders present: Harry Harris, Fred Holland, Harv Buckner, Paul Cook and Roger Brown. Presenters attending: the Preaching Minister, Butch Gastfield; Church Administrator, Chris Callahan; and Chairman of the Deacons, Michael Bolter.

Harry presented the opening meditation and prayer.

The March minutes were accepted and approved.

The Deacon's report was presented by Michael. He mentioned that we have a small number of deacons who are dealing with some medical issues and he asked the elders to lift them up in prayer. Michael shared that the Deacons have covered all the events over the past month. There was a discussion of protocols for deacon coverage at each of the entrance doors prior to services. We continue to strive to provide a cheerful and inviting welcome for our members and guests as they come into our building and worship center. The elders continue to recognize the dedicated support provided by the deacons in every aspect of our church ministries.

The Administrative report was presented by Chris. The March financial report was approved. Chris shared the current status of the Forward Initiative campaign. He also shared details regarding funds on hand and funds needed for Phase 1 of the building project. Chris shared the year-end report from Steeple Accounting Services reflecting a very good assessment result. The report was accepted and approved. It was noted that the FORWARD Update presentation is available in its entirety, to include the questions and answers periods, on the church website for all those who were not able to attend or who desire to review the presentation again.

The Preaching Minister's Report was presented by Butch. In addition, he submitted the monthly written reports provided by each of the Associate Ministers. Butch noted three baptisms during the month of March and the start of two new Discipleship Groups as a result of the last First Step program. Butch also performed a wedding and participated in our church's 25th Anniversary and Groundbreaking Celebration held on April 7th. Coordination and planning work for upcoming Bible studies and themed classes continues. We are expecting a thrilling announcement in the very near future concerning a minister for our church plant. The Vietnam Veterans Celebration held on March 26 was a huge success. The Easter Good Friday service and the weekend services were extremely well attended with favorable responses received from many visitors and members. With two Senior Health and Welfare presentations, well-attended with excellent feedback, March and early April have provided many opportunities

for service, education, worship and excitement for the future.

Under Old Business, discussion centered on the organization, oversight, and coordination with Florida Church Planters in relation to the Fairway church plant. Feeback will be provided at the next scheduled elders meeting in May.

Under New Business, discussion was introduced by Harv about building security during our service hours and regular events. Fred shared details based on his experience with school districts and how they handled security. Chris shared that we may explore putting a security team together to monitor services and events. More to follow on this subject.

The next monthly Elders meeting is scheduled for May 20th.

Recently in our church reception area, I had a conversation with Mary Lou Johnston. She shared how a particular event that happened shortly after she had become a member of Fairway confirmed that she had joined the right church. She has allowed me to share her story in this month's newsletter:

"I have a praise for the people who make up Fairway Christian Church. Just after joining, I was invited to attend the Women's Newcomers Coffee. I didn't know anyone who was there on the Wednesday morning I arrived. Earlier in the week I had learned about a cancer diagnosis our daughter-in-law, Rene', had just received. I couldn't keep from thinking about her. Upon arriving, as I was getting my cup of coffee I asked a lady if there was a prayer chain at this church. She directed me to Geri Gunderson, the ministry leader of Feed My Sheep, who happened to be near the coffee area that morning. When I asked her about putting Rene' on the prayer chain, she immediately wrapped her arm around me, asked more about Rene', and then called all of the ladies who were there to gather around me to pray. As we stood in a prayer circle the ladies prayed for Rene' and for me.

Remember, I didn't know any of these ladies, yet they welcomed me and reached out with warmth and love. Then Geri gave me some soup to take home, a card from the Creative Card ministry, and then took me to pick out a prayer shawl, knitted by the Prayer Shawl ministry, to send to Rene'.

Of all the churches we have attended, never has anything like this happened! That was almost two years ago, and the welcome we've received from others who have since become my dear church sisters and friends have definitely confirmed that this is our church home! God has blessed this church with something very special and unique! My husband and I are so blessed to have found Fairway Christian Church."

Mary Lou Johnston and her husband Bill became members of Fairway in December 2022. We're so glad they are a part of our family! This story reflects what seems to be built into so much of the Fairway family DNA – reaching out and making new people feel welcome and loved! We thank and praise God for His work in us! **We love because He first loved us!** (1 John 4:19)
