Elder Meeting Minutes June 16, 2025

The June Elder's meeting was called to order with the following elders present: Harry Harris, Paul Cook, Jerry Benware, Fred Holland and Roger Brown. Presenters attending: Preaching Minister, Butch Gastfield; Chris Callahan, Church Administrator; Vice-Chairman of the Deacons, John Keeler; and Diana Brown, Directory Update Project Coordinator.

Butch presented the opening meditation and prayer.

The May minutes were accepted and approved.

John Keeler shared that Chris attended the Deacons meeting and gave an update report on the construction. He also mentioned his appreciation for the Elders making themselves available to everyone after the services. The deacons have been very busy over the past several months with the regularly scheduled events and several special events, two funerals and a wedding. Training for the newly added deacons is continuing. John closed by highlighting his excitement about the potential of the new members in our church.

At the request of the elders, Diana Brown presented the project overview, background information and the results of her study for the updating of our church member directory and the associated database. In accordance with the church bylaws, the recommendations to update the directory were approved by the elders. Actions will be implemented immediately to update the current directory by the end of July. The elders agreed to a quarterly review of the directory for contact purposes in conjunction with an annual routine update. The elders thanked Diana for her efforts to develop an orderly and sensitive approach for updating the directory. Chris presented the administrative report. The financial report was reviewed and approved. The Church Administrator reviewed the FORWARD Campaign pledge status and the elders agreed that an update for the congregation will be presented within the next two months. Construction completion is still on track for the end of July with a soft opening for the church tentatively scheduled in mid-August, in preparation for the Grand Opening event in late September. Again, we thank our church members for their flexibility and patience as meeting space availability has been extremely limited for the past month and will be for July also. We continue to stress the importance of everyone being on the lookout for tripping hazards in the areas affected by the construction.

Butch presented the monthly associate ministers' written reports, to include his update on activities since his return from his sabbatical. He has been extremely busy with not only sermon preparation, but a myriad of update and coordination meetings with ministries inside our church, with our church plant and with coordination efforts with churches in the area. The elders expressed their appreciation for Butch's contributions to our church and their pleasure with his constructive return from the sabbatical. In addition, the elders highly praised the accomplishments of our talented and energetic associate ministers in leading our church with distinction during Butch's absence.

Under Old Business, Paul shared details regarding our Missions team trip to Kentucky on June 22, 2025.

Under New Business, discussion centered on concern with the rise of Antisemitism and our role in reviewing opportunities to support efforts concerning this with our missions partners. A request to review our capabilities to offer live stream funeral services to our members was presented. Chris shared that he would work on the details to ensure we can do this as a matter of practice, if requested, and the procedures necessary to ensure privacy and quality of delivery. Chris further stated that we can offer the families a link to share with those who want to see the funeral online if requested in advance. Chris shared we would need to have a waiver signed by the family giving us permission to live stream the service.

The meeting was closed in prayer by Chris. The next monthly Elders meeting is scheduled for July 21, 2025.


