OUTREACH CORNER

Connecting Hearts is continuing to grow with the addition of seven new volunteers in the last few weeks. We serve those who live in assisted living centers, most who have no way to get out to church or have Christian fellowship with others. We do one-on-one relationship building through crafts, musical guests, games, and whatever we can think of to open doors. We share treats and just plain one-on-one conversations.

We also provide Sunday church services, manned by four disciple groups.

We have volunteers who bring shoes for people whose shoes don't fit, carry large print Bibles to give away, bring socks with grippers on them for those without shoes until we can get them a pair, give clothes to someone who has nothing to wear (literally nothing), and take the time to pray for people who are hurting from life. We've been invited to weddings, 90th birthday celebrations, and we've gone to hospitals and bedsides when called. Most importantly, we work to build relationships that allow people to feel safe to share their lives with us.

And just like in the book B.L.E.S.S. that's when the doors of the heart open.

MOAMI Offers Support and Connection Through Life's Transitions. In the bustling world of life transitions, finding a welcoming hand and a listening ear can make all the difference. At Fairway we will launch the next class of MOAMI - Moving on Ministry for women, a heartwarming initiative designed to offer connection, support, comfort, and spiritual growth to women facing life's changes.

Every Thursday from September 11 to November 13, women, in all stages of life, will gather at Fairway, not just to attend a program, but to embark on a journey of shared experiences and mutual support. MOAMI is a beacon for those navigating new beginnings—be it moving to a new place, adjusting to a different phase of life, or seeking a place to connect within a new community.

Each week, participants come together not only to discuss their journeys but to uplift and encourage one another. For many, the relationships formed in MOAMI extend beyond the program, creating a supportive network that lasts long after the ten weeks are over. "I had never met most of the women in my MOAMI group before," one participant reflects. "But by the end of the course, we had built friendships that have endured and supported us for years. It's a wonderful feeling to know that we are there for each other."

The MOAMI program is open to women from all walks of life, regardless of church membership or background. It offers a space for women to gain tools and advice for managing transitions, connect with others in similar situations, and receive spiritual enrichment.
