Spotlight on Lynn Canale- Senior Health & Wellness Ministry Coordinator

Lynn was born in San Francisco, CA and lived in the suburbs during her growing years. She was raised in Millbrae Baptist Church, and she joined Fairway Christian Church years later in May 2018.

Her favorite things to do include playing the piano, scuba diving and spending time with her husband, John and their dog, Emmy. The 3 B's are her favorite foods: burgers, bacon and brie cheese. On her wish list is a trip to visit Yellowstone National Park.

Her favorite scripture reading is from Phillipians 4:13 which reads, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." This always reminds her that her strength comes from Him, not from herself. Her favorite hero is Jesus because He loved without limits, served without seeking reward, and forgave even those who hurt Him. His life tells her how to truly live.

Some of the things that we never knew about Lynn is that as a young nurse, God showed her a miracle and then later spoke to her clearly to reveal a message that has stayed with her for her entire life. In essence, she quoted God saying "Whether a person lives or dies is HIS decision, not yours. You are only the instrument." This message was very powerful, especially because of the events that had occurred at that time. Another thing we did not know about Lynn was that the baseball great Willie Mays, Jr. (The Say Hey Kid) was her patient.

She was and still is licensed as a Registered Nurse and has worked in numerous capacities. Besides working in ICU, ER, and Surgery units, she also did Critical Care Transport (including some flights), teaching and Medical-Legal Consulting. A third item we did not know about Lynn was that as she was preparing to complete her studies to become an Adult Geriatric Primary Care Nurse Practitioner and just about to begin her clinicals, Covid 19 hit and all clinics were shut down, and the Good Lord redirected her path toward something new: developing the Senior Health and Wellness Ministry. H.O.M.E. - Hands of Mercy Everywhere

Fairway Christian Church in The Villages has a strong Women's Ministry. This incredible group of women have been supporting the homeless, pregnant, parenting, or at-risk teen girls from the beginning of the H.O.M.E. ministry.

H.O.M.E. Community Engagement Managers, Tina Talton-St. Germain and Marge Felix came to Fairway for a special event coordinated by Fairway women Carol Tomsey and Kathy Gay that was held on July 22 to provide updates on the H.O.M.E. program.

Tina and Marge shared a video about the program and provided a presentation on how this ministry helps the teen girls. In addition to the three homes where the girls reside, there is a new Lakeside Center – Resource Center that opened last year where the girls attend a variety of educational classes and vocational classes for life skills from a variety of church and business partners in helping to plan their future. They also encouraged Women of Fairway to sign up for in-person tours at H.O.M.E. held every Tuesday morning at 10am.

Carol shared, "We always enjoy hearing what's happening at H.O.M.E. You certainly can see God's hand in all of this and are pleased and blessed to know that the Fairway Women's Ministry have had and continue to have a small part in H.O.M.E.'s journey." Generous donations were collected at the Fairway Women's July Luncheon event on July 17 and at this special July 22 event totaling \$1,103. This was presented to Tina and Marge who were pleasantly surprised and grateful to take back to H.O.M.E. The money raised will help the girls at H.O.M.E. with Back-to-School clothes and other items they will need as they get ready for the new school year.
