when they get food prepared by the loving hands of others.

You would work out the details with H.O.M.E., however, you would make dinner to serve 10 people per house and there are three houses. Houses: FAITH, HOPE & GRACE. The dinners would consist of some type of protein (can be in a casserole, too), a Starch, Salad, and Dessert or Fruit. Very Important: Food needs to be delivered and served in disposable pans and containers. NO personal dishware, plates, etc.
