January Spotlight: Peggy Holland wife of Elder Fred Holland.

Peggy has lived all over the state of Ohio. She was raised in an Evangelical United Brethren Church which merged with the Methodist Church and was renamed The United Methodist Church.

Her work life has been quite varied. She started out babysitting for their neighbor's children. Peggy earned quite an achievement when she took her test for an RN license. Her scores were considered at a National level so she had the reciprocity which allowed her to serve as an RN in any state in the United States without retesting.

Her nursing career consisted of working as a staff nurse on both day and night shifts. She then became the charge nurse for the 7:00 -3:30 PM shift. She then became Director of Nursing for a Community Hospital followed by taking the position of Director of Nursing at a 200-bed nursing rehab and assisted living facility.

Peggy then spent time as nursing supervisor of a physician's office that was part of the Ohio State Medical Program. From that position, she became the supervisor of nursing personnel in a large cardiology office which then expanded to include the front office personnel.

At one point, she was hired to be the headstart lady and pre-school teacher at a church they were attending.

Peggy stated that Jesus is her true hero because he took all our sins upon himself and went to the cross to die for all.

Her favorite type of food is Italian (any variety). Peggy's favorite scripture is John 3:16 *"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."*

Peggy's final move was to The Villages 15 years ago. Her favorite things to do are reading (especially mysteries) walking & visiting with friends, cross-stitching and watching old time favorites on TV.

Peggy and Fred have been members of Fairway Christian Church for 9 years.
