

Elder Meeting Minutes December 15, 2025

The December Elder's meeting was called to order with the following elders present: Harry Harris, Paul Cook, Jerry Benware, Fred Holland, and Roger Brown. Presenters attending: Preaching Minister, Butch Gastfield; Chris Callahan, Church Administrator; and Chairman of the Deacons, Michael Bolter.

Fred presented the opening meditation and prayer.

The November minutes were accepted and approved.

Michael presented the Deacon's report and shared that a number of the deacons currently serving in leadership positions will be changing in the next few months. This will facilitate a rotation of responsibility among the deacons and provide a break for those who have been serving in those positions for the past several years.

Michael gave a special prayer for John Keeler and Karen and highlighted his long service as the Vice-Chairman of the Deacons and in other areas of service in the church as well. Paul Bushman and John Alessandrine will pick up the responsibilities of training the Deacons. Michael mentioned that Gerald Raver and his team did an excellent job managing parking for the Big Band concert, as we had 730 attendees and had only five parking spaces left open. He said that the Women's luncheons are covered for the next six months. Support planning for the busy month of February is in progress.

Chris presented the administrative report. The financial report was reviewed and approved. Discussion addressed annual interest loan payment for the recently completed building expansion. Harry and Roger will be developing and presenting the concept for the debt reduction program which will be ready for finalization at the next Elder's meeting in January. Roger presented the proposed 2026 budget to the congregation on the 6th and 7th of December. Chris shared that copies of the proposed 2026 budget will remain available at the North and West entrances as well as at the Guest services desk in the Gathering Hall for all members to review. The congregational vote for the approval of the 2026 budget will occur on the 20th and 21st of December. (Update: the budget for 2026 was unanimously approved by the congregation). A reminder was addressed that this budget is an increase of almost 10% over the 2025 budget due to the mortgage payment, and increase in utilities and insurance costs. The final punch list is still being addressed and as well as final billing for the project. Chris shared that we had an overwhelming response from our Fairway Family on the Christmas Tree Decorating party. Chris shared that the next church potluck is being scheduled for Sunday, January 11th following the 10:30 am service.

Butch presented the monthly associate ministers' written reports in addition to his activities for the month. Of particular note was the Faith Fundamentals Refresher class presented to all leaders, teachers, and facilitators. It will be provided again in the near future for those who were not able to attend the initial class. He highlighted the awesome Wednesday night meal in the Gathering Area with Unity church's kids singing! It was one of the top nights of the year for us and our church plant! The Christmas Musical, "The Gift of Christmas" was presented twice in early December and was well received. A special thanks to Michael and our marvelous choir. We are truly blessed.

Planning continues for February Christian Restoration Association Summit as well as the Women's Retreat. Sunday morning Bible studies, Wednesday evening Discipleship Hour, hospital visits, phone calls, home visits, ministry support meetings, baptisms, and a myriad of other activities were performed by our wonderful and caring ministerial staff throughout the month. We are a truly blessed church family.

Under Old Business, two new policies were finalized for publication: Church pictorial Directory and Annual Certification for Deacons and Elders.

Under New Business, detailed schedules and plans were requested by the elders for the Ministers' Summit and for the Women's Retreat in February. Chris confirmed that the Valentine's dinner will be held on Friday, February 13th in the Gathering Area. The elders will receive an update from Tom Beckner at the next sidebar meeting to share details of our education programs.

The meeting was closed in prayer by Butch.

The next monthly Elders meeting is scheduled for January 19, 2026.


