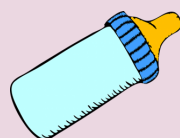

The Baby Bottle Drive is an Outreach fundraiser to support the Alpha Pregnancy Center in Ocala. The Center's mission is to educate, equip, restore and empower women to choose life. They provide items required for children from birth to three years of age such as: Clothing, Formula, Diapers, etc. The Center depends entirely on donations from local churches, businesses and individuals. They do not receive any State or Federal assistance. In 2023 the cost for a child from birth to 3 years in Florida was \$18,814 per year. We ask that you please take a baby bottle following worship services beginning Saturday, February 7<sup>th</sup>, fill it with change, cash or a check and return it to the church one of the next two weekends. This will assist the Center in continuing their mission.

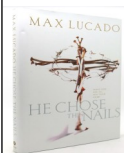

# ELDERS

## Elder Meeting Minutes January 19, 2026

The January Elders meeting was called to order with the following elders present: Harry Harris, Roger Brown, Fred Holland, Jerry Benware, and Paul Cook. Presenters attending: Preaching Minister, Butch Gastfield; Chairman of the Deacons, Michael Bolter; Mike Czerwonky, Chairman, Missions Committee; and Church Administrator, Chris Callahan.

Butch presented the meditation and opening prayer.

The December 2025 minutes were accepted and approved.

Michael presented the Deacons' report. He provided an update on reassignment of several leadership responsibilities as part of rotational moves to provide wider experience. He mentioned that the Women's luncheons are covered for the next six months, to include the February Women's Retreat which will require additional Deacons to support. Finally, he is still coordinating the specific requirements for deacons to support the Ministry Summit in February.

Mike presented a special Missions Committee report addressing the details of the Mexico mission trip conducted last year. Mike shared specific improvements in the planning and execution for a trip back to Mexico this year if approved by the elders. The elders will discuss the safety aspects and overall environment in the region with Bill Warren from FAME who will be attending the Ministry Summit in February. He is well versed in safety of traveling to Mexico on a mission trips. Mike noted that he already has significant interest from members wanting to participate if the elders approve the trip. Mike shared that the Missions committee will be evaluating all the current Missions organizations that Fairway supports with the intent of ensuring proper funding distribution, as this has not been done for several years. The findings will be reported to the Elders at a later date.

Chris presented the administrative report. The December financial reports were reviewed and approved. Chris noted that the church responded well to the end-of-year request to meet a projected shortfall, and as a result, we finished the year a bit above budget and avoided any difficulties with meeting requirements. He reminded the board that the 2026 budget is about 10% larger than last year due to loan interest payments and increased utility costs for the larger facility. The congregation has been alerted to this and we are confident this year will be met with the same type of support our members always demonstrate to support the mission of GO, SOW and GROW. Chris shared that the generosity statements will be sent to our members by end of the January to support 2025 tax preparations. Chris shared that the church potluck on Sunday, January 11th was a remarkable success with approximately 280 in attendance.

The Preaching Minister's Report was provided by Butch. He mentioned that we have the largest First Steps class this month with over sixty new attendees and several current members in attendance. We continue to have an increased number of baptisms, new members and many visitors attending the weekend services. The individual Associate Minister's reports reflect planning and rehearsal activities for the Fairway's Got Talent held at the end of January, upcoming Easter Concert and the Vietnam Remembrance Celebration, to be held in March in addition to special Sunday choir presentations. Ongoing are a myriad of Bible studies, discipleship classes, Discipleship Group activities, small group meetings, home, hospital, and rehabilitation visitations, GriefShare, ministry leaders' meetings, Senior Health and Wellness presentations, Connecting Hearts

visitations, new program development, and many more loving activities too numerous to list. This is not busywork, it is an exciting extension of God's love being demonstrated throughout our church family and the community. What a blessing to be serving in Fairway!

Under Old Business, Butch provided details regarding the upcoming Florida Ministry Summit scheduled for 5-7 February. This is designed to attract an audience of younger ministers, church leaders, and members interested in good preaching and helpful workshops. The preaching and general workshop sessions are also open to our members without charge. Meal events are open only to invited ministry attendees. Attendance sign-up is available on the website under the title of Summit Conference. Harry shared the detailed agenda for the Women's Retreat to be held on February 19th. Jerry gave an update on the Vision Leadership Team.

Under New Business, the elders discussed possibilities more in line with our doctrinal theology for the educational curriculum coming up in the fall. We continue to develop a debt reduction program to communicate with the congregation on a regular basis our financial status to pay off our construction loan and to position ourselves for future expanded ministry opportunities.

The next regular elder meeting is scheduled for Monday, February 16, 2026.

Chris provided the closing prayer.
