



ELDERS

Elder Meeting Minutes February 16, 2026

The February Elder's meeting was called to order with the following elders present: Harry Harris, Paul Cook, Jerry Benware, Fred Holland, and Roger Brown. Presenters attending: Preaching Minister, Butch Gastfield; Tom Beckner, Associate Minister of Discipleship; Chris Callahan, Church Administrator; and Chairman of the Deacons, Michael Bolter.

Chris presented the opening meditation and prayer.

The January minutes were accepted and approved.

Michael presented the Deacon's report and provided an update on the changeover of deacons in leadership positions. This was designed to give some of our long-serving staff deacons a break and to provide a wider leadership experience for the new volunteers. This will increase the overall depth of knowledge and operational expertise for the deacons, as they are such an essential part of the leadership team. February was an extremely busy month for providing support for five major events. By all standards, every event was a huge success and the deacons are to be recognized for their selfless and dedicated service to our church family. Michael highlighted that we have three new deacon candidates who will be interviewed by the elders in early March, potentially bringing the number of deacons up to twenty-four.

Tom Beckner presented an update report on potential source materials for a one-year women's Bible study recommended by a member of our church. Tom, along with several leadership members completed a review of the material and found it to be favorable in content and alignment with Restoration Christian Church doctrine. Tom has spoken to the author and along with the elders, further research will be ongoing. A discussion with women's Bible study teachers and ministry leaders will be scheduled to discuss source materials and potential use of these materials for the coming educational year.

Chris presented the administrative report. The financial report was reviewed and approved. Chris noted that we were a bit below the monthly giving target for the month of January. He shared that we continue to correct Parking Lot issues and are still pursuing closing out the Punch List. He noted that Valentine's dinner was a huge success with approximately four hundred attendees. The Ministry Summit revitalized the Christian Restoration Association (CRA) guests as well as our church family members who attended. The Women's Retreat had over 285 attendees and was truly a worship event and lastly, the Men's Fellowship Breakfast broke an attendance record with 130 men participating. Fairway is growing, reaching out, and expanding the gospel throughout our community!

Butch presented his activities for the month as well as the associate ministers' written reports. Another First Steps class was completed with over sixty-five in attendance and three seven-week follow-on small groups were established to study discipleship principles. The Fairway's Got Talent event was a roaring success. Butch provided an in-depth assessment of the CRA Minister's Summit. Weekly Bible studies are expanding, as is the ministerial support for our church plant (Unity Christian Church) while David Miller was on a much-needed short trip. Additionally, Grief Share sessions, community visitations, memorial services, Senior Health and Wellness meetings, Connecting Hearts Meetings and visits were supported. Also, counseling sessions, staff meetings, home, hospital, and rehab visits, phone calls, and prayers along with bereavement, welcoming and health concerns cards continue in the background of

our worship and special events! Our ministers are providing a wide breadth of caring and personal connections to all our members. Membership continues to grow as do the number of baptisms every week. Five baptisms alone were completed at the same time in the last few days of the month! Praise God!

Under Old Business, Roger shared details regarding the debt reduction presentation tentatively projected for the weekend of March 14th and 15th. Jerry gave an update on the Vision Leadership team and noted that Connie Iscrupe has recently joined the team.

Under New Business, Paul shared the results of an elders meeting held during the Summit regarding the safety of going on a Mexico trip this year. After discussion and with continuing safety checks in place, the elders approved the request for a mission team to plan to go to Mexico this year, based on continuing review of the in-country safety situation prior to the time of departure. Paul shared that they would be joining another mission team from Indiana on this trip.

The meeting was closed in prayer by Jerry.

The next monthly Elders meeting is scheduled for March 16, 2026.
