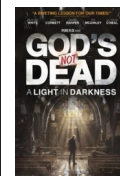

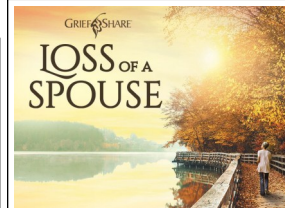

# ELDERS

## Elder Meeting Minutes April 20, 2026

The April Elder's meeting was called to order with the following elders present: Paul Cook, Jerry Benware, Fred Holland, and Roger Brown. Presenters attending: Preaching Minister, Butch Gastfield; Church Administrator, Chris Callahan; and Chairman of the Deacons, Michael Bolter.

Paul presented the opening meditation and prayer.

The March minutes were accepted and approved.

Michael reviewed the farewell luncheon held for Bill McAllister. Bill and Sarah have been long-standing servants in our church and are relocating at the end of April. He highlighted the caring support provided during Susan Jaeger's funeral service and the appreciation shown by everyone for the deacons' roles in the service. He thanked the Women's ministry for the wonderful Thank-You card sent in appreciation for the deacons work throughout the church. Michael shared that a number of the Deacons were table leaders at the Men's BBQ and it turned out well. They continue to support all the events and functions in the church with serving hearts.

Chris presented the administrative report. The financial report was reviewed and approved. He presented the Steeple year-end audit report noting outstanding results. The final FORWARD giving figures were presented as we transition to loan elimination management through the current Debt Reduction Campaign. Only a few small items remain on the construction punch list with the parking lot completion as the main issue. We are holding the last invoice until we obtain resolution regarding this. Chris shared that the celebration for Jim and Cindy Jacobs held on Sunday, April 19th was a great success. Chris continues to look for new software to update our current accounting and membership systems.

Ministerial activities for the month were presented by Butch. A new First Step class was started with 26 potential new members attending. He noted that the Good Friday and all Easter services were extremely well-attended with many visitors and family members. Butch said that he is participating in planning efforts for a 2027 CRA Ministry Summit potentially to be held here on 26-27 February. The Associate Ministers reports include a wide variety of revised and new care programs in process, as well as a "Song Stories" Wednesday Bible Study that began April 8th. We continue to gain new members and had a number of baptisms this month.

Under Old Business, dates for a joint Elders and Ministers meeting are being proposed. Discussion continued to ensure all teachers are aware of the doctrine of Fairway Christian Church and study materials to be evaluated. Plans to discuss this with ministry leaders are underway. Jerry provided an update on the Vision Leadership Team efforts to date, addressing technology, first-time experience, and congregational updates.

Under New Business, Roger shared details regarding the congregational voting process for two new elder candidates and for renewing two serving elders for three-year terms of service. They were presented to the congregation on April 11th and 12th and will be voted on April 25th and 26th.

The meeting was closed in prayer by Fred.  
The next monthly Elders meeting is scheduled for May 18, 2026.
